NEW WORK

Maumee, Ohio — RLI Special Accounts has been awarded the GMP for a new 12,143-square-foot garage building at Spartan Chemical.

GEM has also been awarded contracts to provide steel fabrication, erection of pre-cast and steel, plumbing, HVAC and electrical work as part of the project. The work is scheduled to be completed by early October.

Oakwood, Ohio — RLG's Northeast Ohio office will design and install interior structures to house new calibration equipment for Thermo Fisher Scientific.

RLG will perform structural steel, electrical, HVAC, sheet metal, piping and rough carpentry, as well as install foundations and walls. One structure has walls that are 2-feet, 6-inches thick with a 10-foot wall.

The work is expected to be finished by the end of May.
