RLG's Tera O project at First Solar and Hylant's multi-year contract with GEM Energy and RLP

First Solar, Perrysburg - GEM and RLI are installing a new 138KV design/build, turnkey substation and new 15KV electrical distribution system.

GEM is also reworking the existing Perrysburg facility to convert it from Series 4 modules to Series 6 modules. Because of this change, the electrical distribution, chilled water, compressed air and HVAC systems need to upgraded or replaced.

Once completed, First Solar Perrysburg facility will transform from a four-line manufacturing facility to a two-line manufacturing facility and will have significantly more output.
