RLI breaks ground on Valley Bridge senior living and GEM Energy's solar project for The Rotor Clip Company

Valley Bridge, Toledo – RLI is general contractor and will self-perform site work, concrete, masonry and carpentry for Valley Bridge, a new 70-unit affordable senior housing community in Toledo's Reynolds Corners neighborhood.

National Church Residences and Friendship New Vision, Inc., a non-profit community development affiliate of Friendship Baptist Church, are developing the project.

The 3-story, 65,000-square-foot building will be complete in summer 2018.

Franklin Township, New Jersey – The Rotor Clip Company chose GEM Energy to complete a 4 MW(dc) nameplate, fixed axis ground mount solar project covering approximately 20 acres. The design/build project includes 34,000 panels manufactured by First Solar.

Along with the solar array, GEM Energy is designing and upgrading the building electrical services for three manufacturing buildings. This will accommodate the new loads and future growth of Rotor Clip.

Construction is anticipated to begin in November and will wrap up in June 2018.
