GEM ARRIVES AT FIRST SOLAR AND RLG BEGINS WORK AT ARCELORMITTAL

GEM has been awarded electrical and mechanical work at First Solar including:

- Building and CUB electrical packages.
- Installation of all electrical systems.
- Plumbing for the entire facility.
- Storm, sanitary and gas piping.

Along with an aggressive project schedule, the 1-million-square-foot building requires all sanitary exit piping to be 14 feet underground.

RLI is the design/build contractor. Work began in mid-September and will be complete by summer of 2019.
