Ohio CAT, Perrysburg – **RLI** and **GEM** are trades contractors for Ohio CAT's new 160,000-square-foot campus:

RLI is performing building and site concrete and carpentry, and 550,000 square feet of concrete pavement. **GEM** is performing HVAC, plumbing and electrical.

RLG is renovating Hylant's 8th and 9th floors, a 22,000-square-foot design-build project scheduled for completion in mid-September.

RLI is providing preconstruction and construction management services for Hylant, and self-performing demolition, millwork and coordinating MEP upgrades as well as a FALK brand modular wall system and furniture installation.

GEM is providing preconstruction design/ estimating assistance and upgrading HVAC and plumbing, structural steel support for an operable wall system, electrical, LED lighting, fire alarm and HVAC controls.

GEM electricians are prefabricating wiring and controls for LED fixtures and about 300 in-wall devices, coordinated with the FALK supplier to ensure fast and on-time installation.
