
Toledo Edison building facade, BASF roller hearth kiln

Toledo Edison building facade, downtown Toledo - RLG is partnered with SSOE to construct a new two-story facade along the Toledo Edison building after the connector bridge between the Toledo Edison, HCR and Toledo Trust buildings is demolished.

The Toledo Edison building was purchased in 2016 by ProMedica and is part of its downtown headquarters complex.

RLI is self-performing masonry and concrete. **GEM** is performing structural steel modifications.

Work will be complete in May 2021 before the City of Toledo's streetscape project and the Solheim Cup opening ceremony at Promenade Park.

BASF Beachwood roller hearth kiln

- GEM is performing electrical, piping, insulation and equipment setting to install a roller hearth kiln at BASF Beachwood's R&D pilot plant.

GEM will transport, rig and set the kiln. The project involves routing new utilities such as compressed air, nitrogen and oxygen piping, electrical power and exhaust ventilation.

Installation is being coordinated closely with plant operations so ongoing R&D processes are not disturbed. The project wraps up in early February.






On the move: Transferring to our Michigan office
