After his presentation, the GEM VDC team purchased their own Matterport camera, then gave a demo to the RLI VDC team, who also bought a camera.

The technology has helped both GEM and RLI quote and win projects.

"When I see a different way of doing something, it might not work for GEM, but I'll bring it to RLI's attention," says **John Marshall**, VDC manager at GEM.

Sheet metal fabrication

- With air balancing of HVAC systems, owners can be assured that fresh, outdoor air is provided to the building, increasing indoor air quality.
- Air and water balancing optimizes an HVAC system - ensuring that it functions properly with temperatures consistent throughout the facility.
- Testing/balancing is required for new construction and expansion/addition occupancy permits.

American National Standards Institute (ANSI) certified fire/fire smoke dampers inspection and repairs

Certified inspections are required



Motor amp reading is part of testing/balancing, ensuring that the motor is operating within the ratings, not over amping - and saving electrical costs for the owner.

every four years for commercial buildings and every six years for hospitals with operating rooms.

- Inspections verify that all fire life safety dampers are operating correctly.
- Dampers should be tested and repaired as needed to protect against fire and smoke.
- Testing verifies that there is no interference, ensuring that dampers function properly.

National Air Duct Cleaners Association (NADCA) certified duct cleaning of HVAC systems

- NADCA recommends annual inspections of HAVC systems
- Clean HVAC Systems reduce energy cost by over 30 percent.
- Ductwork cleaning keeps a facility properly conditioned as inside and outdoor air is drawn through ductwork to an HVAC unit, passing through a filter that protects mechanical equipment from dust and debris.
