GEM SERVICE OFFERS HYDRO JETTING New service helps keep customers' money from going down the drain



The hydro jetting machine sends water through clogged pipes and drains at 4,000 PSI.

There has long been a need for many GEM Service customers to have someone they can rely on if a drain or pipe at their facility becomes clogged – especially if it's at 3 a.m. on a Sunday.

GEM Service, in response to numerous customer requests about drain and pipe cleaning, has invested in a hydro jetting machine to quickly deal with the clog and get the customer operating normally again.

"This cuts through just about anything," GEM Service Regional Manager **Chris Weeks** said. "This unit gives us the ability to clear drain lines throughout an entire facility."

Debris from manufacturing processes can get in floor drains and interfere with the facility's normal operations.

A technician uses a hose with a special cutting head to blast high-pressure water into the pipe and clear the clog. The machine has enough hose length to run from the facility to the street or in reverse.

GEM Service has one technician trained to operate the jetter and will be training others in the near future.

a professional construction technology position.

GEM has had a co-op in its VDC Department for a few years. At RLI, Vogelsong moves from project to project, but he says VDC Manager **Trent Mahaney** makes sure he is not overwhelmed.

"There are so many different projects you can work on," said Vogelsong, whose goal is to work for RLI after graduation. "It feels like I'm helping out on all of them."

NEW WORK

Woodville, Ohio — GEM is performing the electrical work on a building addition at the Martin Marietta quarry site for their West Lime Load Out operation.

The addition includes a new electrical room. The work includes electrical equipment installation and power feeds and controls for new process equipment, along with general power and lighting.

There are multiple contractors on the site whose jobs impact GEM's work, which will also need to be performed under Mine Safety and Health Administration requirements.

Luckey, Ohio — The transformation of the never-used former Peloton building to a First Solar warehousing facility has begun.

RLI started fine grading with the first slab pour in mid-March.

RLI expects to form, pour and finish 793,000 square feet of 8-inch unreinforced slab for the project. There will be about 30 slab pours over 13 weeks with the project wrapping up by June 28.
